

Disclosure of Institutional Graduation & Completion Rates 2021

UACCM is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation and completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Student Right to Know Act of 1990. The rates reflect the graduation, completion and transfer-out status of a cohort of students who enrolled during the fall 2017 semester and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed. The **cohort** of an institution includes all first-time, degree or certificate-seeking undergraduate students that begin in the stated cohort year.

During the fall semester of 2017, 407 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered the University of Arkansas Community College at Morrilton. One hundred fifty-one of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs within 150% of normal time resulting in a 37% graduation rate. Fifty-six students transferred to another college or university without completing a certificate or degree giving a transfer rate of 14%.

- Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
