Admission Process

Eligible Applicants

- Admitted to UACCM.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale.
- Grade of "C" or better for all pre-requisite courses. *
- Must hold a current Nursing Assistant license or have Nursing Assistant listed on their transcript within the last two years.
- Pre-requisites must all be completed prior to the start of the program.
- Math for Nurses requires a placement score of: 17 ACT Math section OR 27 Compass Algebra OR 48 ACCUPLACER Elementary Algebra OR 230 ACCUPLACER NG QAS OR a grade of 'C' or better in Applied Technical Math, MATH1253
- **Composite** score of 140 or higher on the NEX exam.
- Letter of good standing for applicants *who have previously attended a PN program.*

**Official transcripts for all pre-requisite courses taken at other colleges must be submitted to the Admissions Office for transfer credit evaluation.*

All eligible applicants will be scored based on the following weighted points system.
